

SOUTH BASS ISLAND LIGHTHOUSE

Visitors can climb the stairs to take in a great view of Put-in-Bay from the top of the tower, which is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. The grounds are open to the public dawn to dusk most days, but are occasionally closed for private events.

SOUTH BASS ISLAND STATE PARK

Perched atop the white cliffs of South Bass Island, this unique 33-acre park is a scenic landmark which allows visitors great views and access to Lake Erie en their schoe beautiful Lake Erie on their stone beach and play on the playground overlooking the water. The wooded campground and serene lakeside picnic area offer a quiet retreat from the bustle of downtown.

PERRY'S VICTORY & INTERNATIONAL PEACE MEMORIAL

Rising 352 feet above Lake Erie, Perry's Victory and International Peace Memorial is the most dominant feature of the Lake Erie Islands. After a climb of 37 steps to the lower landing, an elevator takes visitors to the tallest open air observation deck in the National Park Service. The Perry's Victory Visitor Center is free and open to the public. Black Powder Demonstrations, Ranger and Junior Ranger programs are some of the activities offered.

AQUATIC VISITOR'S CENTER

KIMBERLY'S CAROUSEL

Kimberly's Carousel is one of the country's oldest, original carousels, built in 1917 with original wooden horses and "Petey the Perch." Kids of all ages love the island's carousel. Tickets can be purchased inside the Carriage House.

CRYSTAL CAVE & HEINEMAN'S WINERY

Discovered by workers in 1897 while digging a well for the winery 40 feet above, Crystal Cave is the world's largest geode. The walls of this cave are covered in strontium sulfate, a blueish mineral called celestite. Tour Crystal Cave and Heineman Winery and your kids even get to sample fresh Island grape juice.

LAKE ERIE ISLANDS NATURE & WILDLIFE CENTER

JANE COATES WILDFLOWER TRAIL

A half-mile loop trail offering views of a variety of wildflowers as well as migratory songbirds.

MASSIE CLIFFSIDE PRESERVE

Follow this trail system for birdwatching, walking, photography, kayak launching, and nature study. Commemorative benches on the cliffs's edge allow visitors to enjoy harebells, columbines, and hoptree, as well as great sunsets.

SCHEEFF EAST POINT PRESERVE

This 8.8 acre parcel is one of the last remaining natural settings for people to enjoy the Lake Erie Islands, offering spectacular views of Lake Erie and the surrounding islands. East Point's rocky shores and upland cover provide habitat for the Lake Erie Watersnake, migratory songbirds, waterfowl, and a host of shoreline plants. The area offers excellent birdwatching, and access for kayakers.


